Events devoted to Nestor Markov 180th anniversary

In this note we briefly enlist some recent events in memoriam of the 180th anniversary of Nestor Markov a Bulgarian Revival teacher, lexicographer textbooks author and statesman.

In July 2016 (17–31) an exhibition of textbooks, dictionaries and other written materials was organized in the library of the Institute of Mathematics and Informatics at the Bulgarian Academy of Sciences. Most of N. Markovs textbooks in mathematics and physics were exposed including his first textbooks and problem collections of the years 1869 and 1971.

In October 2016 the Haskovo Regional History Museum published a jubilee newspaper devoted to N. Markov's life and activities.

On November 1st 2016 the Pleven Regional History Museum jointly with the community center "Saglasie 186" opened an exhibition of Bulgarian textbooks of the 19th century featuring a new book related to Nestor Markov [1].

In November (21–25) 2016 an exhibition devoted to Nestor Markov was organized in the central building of the Bulgarian Academy of Sciences.

On November 8th, 2016, newspaper Standart published an article in memoriam of N. Markov [2].

On November 24th 2016 in the Institute of Bulgarian Language "L. Andreichin" at the Bulgarian Academy of Sciences organised a jubilee scientific session entitled "Nestor Markov and his contribution to lexicography and education". The presentations of the session were published in an jubilee collection of scientific papers edited by prof. D. Blagoeva [3].

In January 10–31, 2017, the St. St. Cyril and Methodius National Library presented the exhibition "Nestor Markov—a leader of the Bulgarian National Revival". The exhibition was opened by Dr. K. Aleksandrova, director of the library, welcome speeches were given by Prof. Dr. P. Kenderov, prof. Dr. V. Drensky, Prof. Dr. D. Blagoeva and Prof. Dr. M. Mladenova [4].

In March 13–31, 2017, a part of the exhibition "Nestor Markov—a leader of the Bulgarian National Revival" was presented in the "Zaharii Kniazheski" Regional Library in Stara Zagora [5].
